The IB Diploma Programme (DP) is an academically challenging and balanced programme of education with final examinations that prepares students, aged 16 to 19, for success at university and in life beyond. It has been designed to address the intellectual, social, emotional and physical well-being of students. The programme has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities.

Approaches to teaching

There are six key pedagogical principles that underpin all IB programmes. Teaching in IB programmes is:

based on inquiry

focused on conceptual understanding

developed in local and global contexts focused on effective teamwork and collaboration differentiated to meet the needs of all learners informed by assessment (formative and summative)

Approaches to learning

This area covers essential skills that include skills of behaviour and emotional management, skills that allow the student to monitor their own effectiveness in their learning and skills that allow them to process information effectively (often called "study skills" in a school environment).



Curriculum & Subjects Offered

IBDP students must choose one course from each of five subject groups delivering a breadth of knowledge and understanding in their best language, Furthermore, students must also choose either an arts course from the arts group or a second course from one of the other subject groups. DP courses can be taken at HL or SL. At least three and not more than four are taken at higher level (240 teaching hours), while the remaining courses are taken at standard level (150 teaching hours). Students can study and take examinations in English, French or Spanish. Two courses are classified as interdisciplinary meaning that they satisfy the requirements of more than one subject group. In addition to disciplinary and interdisciplinary study, the DP features three core elements that broaden students' educational experience and challenge them to apply their knowledge and skills.


CREATIVITY, ACTIVITY, SERVICE

EXTENDED EASSY

EE is a 4,000-word independent research project. It allows students to explore a personally interesting topic related to one of their six DP subjects or adopt an interdisciplinary approach with a world studies extended essay.

Recognition of IBDP for Admissions to Undergraduate Programmes

Apart from a worldwide acceptance, Indian universities also accept the IB Diploma as equivalent to Class 12 qualification from an Indian board.

The IB Diploma has been recognized by the AIU as an entry qualification to all universities in India since 1983 and renewed in 2010.

According to AIU: "The International Baccalaureate Diploma has been equated with +2 stage (Grade 12) qualification of an Indian Board since 1983. Pupils intending to join Indian Universities after completion of their IB qualifications are eligible to pursue Bachelor's degree programme at Indian Universities. Those intending to join Professional Degree programme are required to have studied the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and English at the qualifying level." (AIU, Dec, 2010).

Higher education institutions around the world admit students based on their IB credentials, and many have specific admissions policies and guidelines for IB students. Admissions criteria can vary widely across educational systems and selectivity of the institution.
