CAMBRIDGE INTERNATIONAL AS & A LEVEL

A Level is a two-year course which includes Cambridge International Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS Level - Equivalent to grade 11) and Cambridge International Advanced Level (A Level - Equivalent to grade 12).

This qualification is pursued in high school by 16 to 19-year-old students from over 160+ countries, in order to prepare themselves for the universities and their higher education.

Cambridge International A Level qualification is globally recognised and valued in India and abroad.

This Programme is accepted as an entry qualification by universities in India and as a 10+2 qualification by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) into all professional and undergraduate courses.









GRADING AND ASSESSMENT

- ➤ There is an assessment at the end of both programmes. Most subjects pursued in AS Level – Year 1 can be continued in A Level – Year 2.
- Separate certificates are issued for each examination series.
- A Level is reported on a grade scale from 'A*' (highest) to 'E' (minimum required performance). There is no A* grade for AS Level, which is reported from grade 'a' to 'e'.
